CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

The scholarship committee of the Miami Nation of Indians of the State of Indiana will select scholarship winners based on the following:

1. The recipient must be at least a second-semester high school senior, planning to enroll or be enrolled in a college/university, or trade school within the boundaries of the United States; a recipient must be or plan to be a full-time student.
2. The recipient must be an enrolled member of the Miami Nation of Indians of the State of Indiana for at least 12 months prior to applying.
3. The recipient cannot be a member of any other Native American Tribe.
4. The recipient must demonstrate tribal involvement and lineage.
5. The recipient must display a history of making good grades.
6. High school students must show good attendance.
7. A photograph of the recipient is highly suggested, but it is not used to determine scholarship winners.
8. The application must be submitted in full.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST BE ATTACHED AND COMPLETE

HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

- A. Two recommendations from the high school dean, counselor, or teachers.
- B. A high school transcript of the junior year and first semester of the senior year.
- C. A personal essay providing additional and other information you feel pertinent (include family/tribal lineage, tribal involvement, hobbies, economic need, goals, etc.). List any awards, outstanding achievements or extra-curricular activities.

COLLEGE STUDENTS

- A. The previous year of grades with the student's name & school attending must be submitted.
- B. A current recommendation from your professors or employers from the past or present.
- C. A personal essay providing additional and other information you feel pertinent (include family/tribal lineage, tribal involvement, hobbies, economic need, goals, etc.)
- D. A minimum of 12 semester hours must be taken.

If you are selected for a scholarship, you will be notified by mail. The award will be mailed directly to you when your proof of enrollment is sent to the scholarship committee. A paid registration receipt will be acceptable.

Applicants NOT selected will also receive a letter via mail.
